

# Post Discharge Information Update Request

## For Warfarin Patients Currently Monitored by QML Pathology

The QML Pathology Warfarin Care Clinic provides a service monitoring the warfarin doses of patients for general practitioners and specialists.

When a patient is admitted into hospital this service is temporarily discontinued and must be reactivated. To assist in maintaining a safe INR, the dosing Haematologist requires the discharging hospital to supply the Warfarin Care Clinic with an updated health and medication history including recent warfarin doses and INR results. The medico-legal consequences of blind dosing are an issue that can involve both the laboratory and the referring physician.

Patients discharged from hospital who are prescribed LMWH must remain under the care of the hospital, or be referred to their doctor until LMWH is ceased and INR returns to therapeutic range (unless under a private specialist). If you wish QML Pathology to commence the monitoring of warfarin doses and INRs for a new patient, please contact the Warfarin Care Clinic on 1300 795 355.
